The future success of our Wing also requires us to continually recruit new membership. New members bring fresh perspectives, new energy and drive, and of course can help lighten the workload for the rest of us! I challenge each of you to bring 3 new interested parties to our meetings, work parties, fly-ins and other events. Open staff positions and basic job descriptions include:

Finance Officer: Responsible for financial recordkeeping, as well as determining volunteer's voting eligibility.

**Safety Officer:** Safety is EVERYONE'S responsibility! The Safety officer works closely with the Maintenance officer, and includes supervising all ground movements of flight operations.
